Happy Christmas everyone,

This term has certainly been a long one and the children have been working hard right up to the Christmas festivities. We have had a lot of great events this term with visitors to the school (including a Roman soldier and an inflatable planetarium) as well as special event days. We hope the children have enjoyed the different opportunities.

We also carried out a parent survey at the parent consultation meeting. It was great to see so much positive feedback. One area for development which was highlighted was around communication: information was being missed in emails or sometimes it was not given far enough in advance. As a result, we have researched a variety of ways that we can improve this and one which seems the most effective is Edulink.

Edulink is an app that can be downloaded on your phone and will beep to notify you of any messages (if your phone notifications are turned on). This seemed the most effective way to communicate as all the information required will be in one place: calendars, events, newsletters, letters, PD stamps and warnings, attendance, club information etc. It also allows parents to update their contact details so we definitely have the right contact details, to report attendance directly, to ask quick questions to staff, as well as giving consent for events and trips and also make payments for dinners or uniforms purchases or trips.

This also links to the system the Secondary school uses so many of you may already be familiar with how it works. **There is a link to a demonstration that you can look at:**

Extending the school day at Hornsea Burton in September 2024

The government have stated that the school week must be 32.5 hours. This means that Hornsea Burton are 50 minutes too short every week so to rectify this we will be going back to the finishing time being 3:30pm from September 2024. This will be in line with Skipsea school and meet the government requirements of 32.5 hours a week.

This will also fit in better with our timetable - at the end of the day every class has a valuable daily storytime and the current timetable often means this is rushed.
