## Happy New Year everyone.

The children have returned and settled well into routines and are enjoying their learning. Class newsletters will have been sent out to inform you of the new areas of learning for this term. Welcome to our new nursery children. They have settled in to school life really well and are enjoying exploring their new surroundings. This has been a smooth transition due to the stay and play sessions.

We certainly had an interesting end of term with lots of sickness due to an increase in flu throughout the population. Most people seem to have returned well which is great news. The advice currently is to keep following the hygiene rules we had before. Children should stay off if they have a temperature or sickness or diarrhoea but otherwise it should be safe to attend -see poster on page 2. Skipsea Primary sadly had to cancel their Nativity before Christmas but they will be doing their play on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> January. The children have remembered their lines really well so we hope you will enjoy it just as much after Christmas as you would have done before.



## Y4 multiplication test and TTRS practice

The year 4 multiplication tables check consists of an on-screen check with 25 times table questions. They will have 6 seconds to answer each question. The whole test takes about 5 minutes to complete. Every year 4 child takes the test in school in June but to prepare your child we practice with games like Times Table Rock star. By using the studio setting, it is very similar in style to the test and helps them get used to the speed. If you could encourage your children, especially in year 3 and 4, to go on this programme regularly then this will really help them -not only in the test but for all the practical applications in maths. You will receive their score in the end of year class report. There is no pass mark for the check.

## Procedures for breakfast club

If you would like to book your child/children into breakfast club then please contact the office at least 24 hours before needing the place -this is to ensure staff are in school with the correct amounts for breakfast and equipment needed. Children need to be booked in and paid for in advance to ensure their place is reserved.

Children who attend our breakfast club do really enjoy these sessions as on different days, activities are planned such as art and craft, computer educational games and board games. Mrs Hall runs this club at Skipsea and Mrs Toth at Hornsea Burton.





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We have worked hard to improve the EYFS area at Hornsea Burton and Skipsea. We have lots of new resources at both schools now. The grass area at Hornsea Burton has been replaced and is great for the children to access in all weathers. Our next step is to clear the grass area in EYFS at Skipsea and lay artificial grass so the children can have the same opportunity. The tree has been removed and the canopy is about to be. We hope to replace this with a better one. We are striving to make our learning environments the best we can.

# Should I keep my child off school?

## Yes

### Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

### Attendance

We are looking in school to try to improve the attendance of our children at school. After Covid lockdowns and attendance rules, it is difficult to change our mindset again and go back to when to attend school.

The key messages given out to schools around the current situation is to send your child if they are just feeling poorly and schools will send them home if they continue to be unable to access learning.

If your child has a temperature then they should be kept off until they no longer have a temperature. Illnesses such as sickness and diarrhoea are included on the poster.

We hope this helps with deciding what to do. The Government has provided additional guidance which can be accessed on their website. If unsure then please ask at our office.
