


# Hornsea Burton and Skipsea Federation



## The Kit List:

### CLOTHING

Clothes are likely to suffer wear and tear and also get dirty and/or wet therefore you should bring several changes of old clothes for doing activities.

- Tops & jackets**
    - T-shirts
    - Long sleeved shirt/T-shirts
    - Waterproof jacket
    - Fleece/jumpers
  - Trousers or leggings**  
but not jeans as they get heavy and cold when wet
  - Underwear & socks**
  - 1 or 2 sets of **clothes for the evening**
  - Suitable **nightwear**
- Your arms will need to be covered to do some activities.*
- Your socks will need to cover your ankles to do some activities.*

### FOOTWEAR

- 2 pairs of trainers**
  - 1 for activities
  - 1 old pair for watersports
- 1 pair of dry shoes**  
for evening activities

### OTHER ITEMS

- 2 towels**
  - 1 for showering
  - 1 old one for activities
- Reusable **drinks bottle**
- Small **rucksack/bag**
- Labelled **bin bag** for wet and dirty clothing
- Sleeping bag or duvet** and pillow (unless otherwise advised)



We would also recommend bringing:

- a torch
- toiletries in a washbag
- waterproof clothing if you have it
- sunglasses, suncream & a hat given that it will be summer
- pyjamas & slippers
- items to keep you entertained like books and playing cards (no electronic devices)

### How to Keep Kids Safe on YouTube

Keeping kids away from inappropriate YouTube content can feel overwhelming. There are several billion YouTube videos (500+ hours of video are uploaded every minute), and 2 billion users log into YouTube every month — so how do we filter out all of the violent, sexual, manipulative, hateful, and otherwise unsuitable content that our kids find on YouTube (frequently by accident)?

This is a useful website to help you set up parental controls. Relying on YouTube's filters isn't good enough and inappropriate content can still sometimes get through the blocks. The advice in this blog should be really helpful.
