Hello,
Wow, what a packed half term we had: Tour de Britain, Harvest festival, parent consultation meetings, 'Stay and Play' in EYFS, phonics meetings and 'Stay and Phonic' sessions and 'Stay and Read' sessions, forest school, active week at Skipsea, nocturnal animals visited in class 1 & 2 and Wonderdome spectacular for class 4. This term we have arranged a history visit for class 3 and an active week for Hornsea Burton, as well as many other fun learning opportunities and Christmas events -see the diary dates which have been moved to page 3 to prevent anyone missing them. Thank you for all the responses in our parent questionnaire which was overwhelmingly positive and encouraging regarding the journey of our school. There were some suggestions made to further improve our school, especially around making our communication with parents clearer. We are exploring other systems, that don't just rely on email or paper copies stuffed in bags, and may be more accessible. We will keep you informed about these developments.



Wrap around care



We now have breakfast clubs at both schools and an after-school club at HB. Please could parents and carers, where possible, reserve a week before the require the place and pay in advance. All sessions are available subject to Availability. Unfortunately staff are unable to take payment at the door. Fees **should, where possible,** be paid by electronic transfer. No place will be given without prior payment (unless an emergency arises). Fees are charged if attendance is booked and the child does not attend.

One big focus this year is our outdoor learning spaces as this provides exciting learning opportunities for our children and we are lucky enough to have the space to develop these. Our forest schools are developing and with the addition of 100s of trees planted at the end of last year, these are becoming an established learning environment. We have a Daily mile track at both schools with outdoor gym equipment. At Skipsea we have an amphitheatre and at Hornsea Burton a peace garden.

Both EYFS areas at Hornsea Burton and Skipsea have been expanded and turfed with artificial grass. The areas were then designed by our EYFS staff where their creativity and vision came into play. At the beginning of half term it was wonderful to see the community come together with staff and parents to start to put together Hornsea Burton. Over the next year both Hornsea Burton and Skipsea areas will develop and evolve so if you have painting or planting skills then please let us know and be involved in making our outdoor spaces even better.

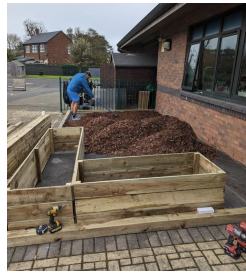
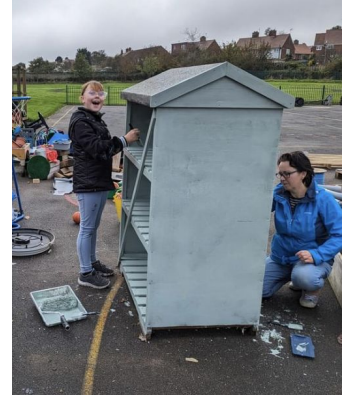
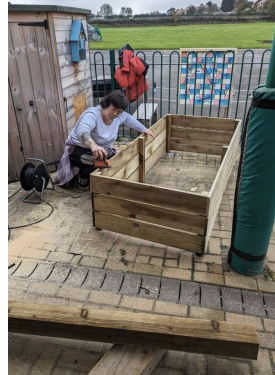

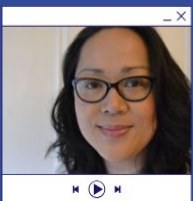
Autumn 2 Class Novels

As always, we have some exciting class novels that will be getting underway this half term.

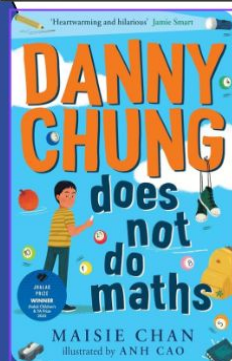
