Welcome back,

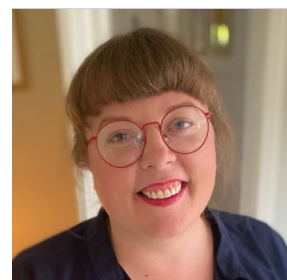

Residential visit this year!

We are planning to go on another residential visit this year and we have provisionally booked a weekend in June - Friday 21st to Sunday 23rd. This will once again be taking place at Willersley Castle. To make it different from last year, we will be using the tent accommodation and taking part in new activities such as Via Ferrata. This is a premium activity. The full price is £170 with everything included: coach, accommodation, food & activities. A £50 deposit is required by the end of October to secure your child's place. The rest of the £120 will be due in March although we have suggested a payment scheme of £20 a month. I am sure lots of the children who attended last year would be more than happy to tell you what a wonderful time we had! 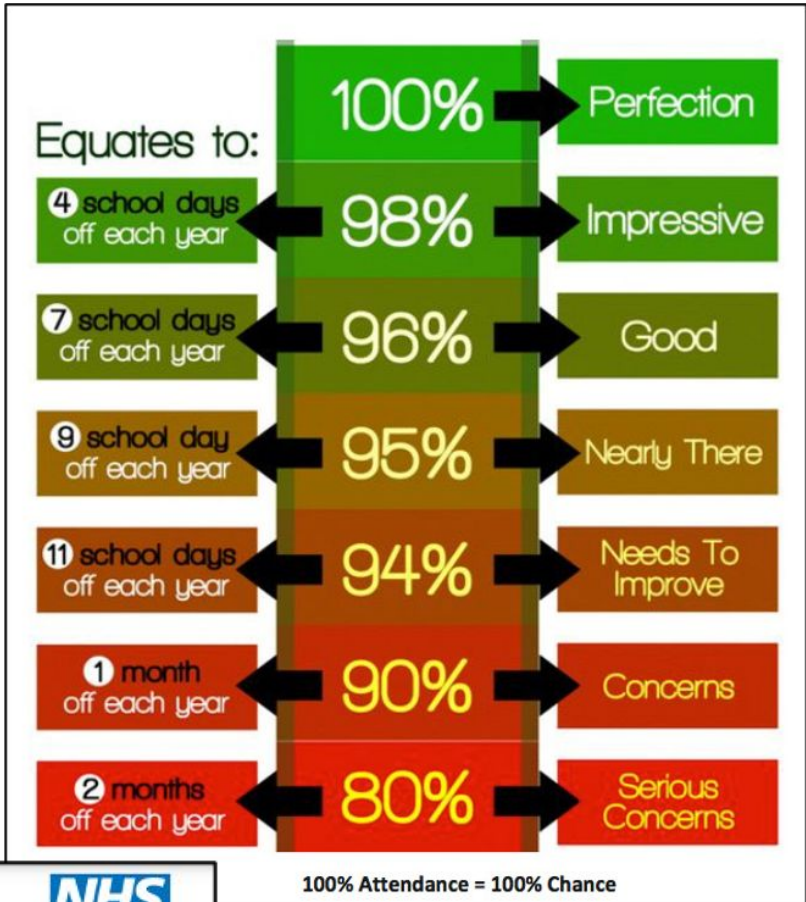
